## Thursday

- Waharoa Flying field open for practice.

## Thursday Night 6:30pm

- Meet and Greet with International Guests at the big field Marque / Party Venue !
- Pizza supplied as part of your entry. Bar service will be running. We are having a Mobile EFTPOS onsite this year, so you can run up a tab, or just keep swiping.
- Round 1 Unknowns dished out
- All pilots Draw flight order. If you're not there, don't be shocked if you're up 1st !
- Foamies and Trojan Racing till dark.

## Saturday Night—The Big Rumble Party !!!

- Beers and Bullshit from 5:00 - Unknown Round 3 available
- The RC Bandit Hobbyzone Undie Hundy !! This could be the main event .... everyone will be involved, and lot of laughs. See a few pages down for the details on this crazyness.
- Spit Roast Dinner at the field in the big Marque. \$30 bucks a head. We've tried Matamata Restaurants for the past few years, and its just a hassle. So we decided how about a big Marque right on the flightline, with a Spit Roast Dinner. No hassles driving home, you can walk / stagger back to the cabins in 5 mins. So the Bar service will be running again, remember the Mobile EFTPOS ... so it'll be Beers and Bullshit till the wee hours of Sunday Morning. So, we need to know in advance to get the catering numbers correct. Tick the box on the entry form, and pay for this at the same time as your entry fee.

## **The Rumble Flyoff**

- On Sunday afternoon we will run the Rumble Flyoff. Here's how it works ... just in case you can't remember from last year
- The winner of each class automatically gets an entry into the Rumble Flyoff (this is to stop any sand bagging by people like Lurch and Browney).
- At least 4 more names will be drawn at random.
- These lucky pilots will then fly one known sequence each, in front of the same judges that they've had all weekend.
- This is a contest against yourself. Who ever betters their own personal average score (based on the previous known rounds flown) by the biggest margin, will win the big prizes !!

## **Sunday Prize Draw !!!**

Once again we have some great sponsors. Last year the total retail value of the prizes was over \$12,500. Desert Aircraft have started off the prize table with 3 DA Motors. A DA-50, a DA-85, and a DA-100 twin. We will announce the rest of the prizes as we get closer to the event on the Flying Giants Rumble Thread.

BTW—To be eligible for the prize draw, you must make an attempt to fly in the majority of the contest rounds. So if you turn up and crash on round 1, you'll need to fly a borrowed model, or get repairing if you think you're walking away with a major prize !

If you're a paid up member of the NZRCAA, you will get a bonus ticket in the draw.

## **Other Info**

- Basic do not fly Unknowns.
- Two flightlines will be run where possible. As we have some International Guests, all flying borrowed models, so we may choose to run Unlimited/Advanced on a single flightline.
- Frequencies - Please supply an alternate frequency (unless you're on 2.4 ghz). Especially if you fly on 40 Meg, or a popular channel. We don't want 5 guys in Sportsman all on 485. Borrow some xtals if you think you need to. We all want to get lots of flying in. Frequency clashes will slow down the comp and create havoc for the CD. This event is about flying, not waiting for the peg.
- Jobs - Its going to a busy 3 days, so don't expect to sit on your bum watching it all happen. Everyone will have a job to do, whether its penciling, judging, typing scores in the computer or flipping burgers. Be prepared.
- Wings Badge - You MUST be an NZMAA paid up member, and have a wings badge for the type of model you intend to fly at the Rumble ! Remember to bring your NZMAA card and wings badge for registration.
- Safety—There are some stringent rules for flying at Waharoa. There are full size and parachuting activities happening at the same time on the adjacent runway. Go to the Matamata Piako Club Website to read the details on this. Here is the link:

# RC Bandit Hobby Zone -Undie Hundie

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5 teams of 5-7 fliers will compete to complete 100 laps of a obstacle course with a mode 2 Hobby Zone Super Cub.

## Equipment provided to each team.

1 x 12 pack of "Rumble Juice"

1x bottle opener

1x pair of jumbo undies

1 x Hobby Zone mode 2 ready to fly Super Cub

1x can of spray paint

1x bottle of Kicker



1 x pack of sponsors stickers

1x bottle of thick cyno

1 x roll of 100mph tape

## The Challenge

1. Your team must complete your Hobby Zone kit from the box, decorate it (prizes will be awarded for best scheme). You must then in turns complete 100 laps of the obstacle course with your Hobby Zone Super Cub.
2. The winning team of the event will have completed 100 laps, have a flying aircraft, no juice left and have adhered to the below rules.

## The Rules:

1. Each pilot can only do 10 laps at a time, so you will have to work out which pilots will do two stints and the plane must complete a takeoff and landing each time the pilot is changed.
2. But I fly Mode 1, and the Cubs are on Mode 2 ... yes we know that, it's a Cub for christ sake. Any Bonifide Mode 2 Pilots must use their "other" hand when flying !
3. Each pilot must finish 1 bottle of "Rumble Juice" while flying their ten lap stint, the next pilot cannot start until the previous pilot has finished their "juice" (this is easy when your flying mode 2). Aunty we will permit you to add lemonade to yours, and make it into a "Rumble Shandee".
4. The pilot flying will be recognised by wearing an extremely large pair of Y- fronts in full view of the adjudicator while airborne for their 10 laps. So you must change the underpants when the cub lands, and before the next guy can take off.
5. Each pilot will nominate their "Pit Bitch" who will also double as their safety advisor and spotter. Only the Pit Bitch can retrieve the aircraft should it meet terafirma or another craft. The Pitch Bitch is responsible for any battery changes. The entire team can work on running repairs.
6. All aircraft and team members must be inside their designated pit area to make battery changes, pilot changes, and repairs.
7. The Adjudicator for the event has the final say, there is no committee and he/she is always right.
8. No complaints allowed / if you don't like the rules don't come!
9. You must have fun, laugh a lot, and tell lies afterwards about how great your flying was !
